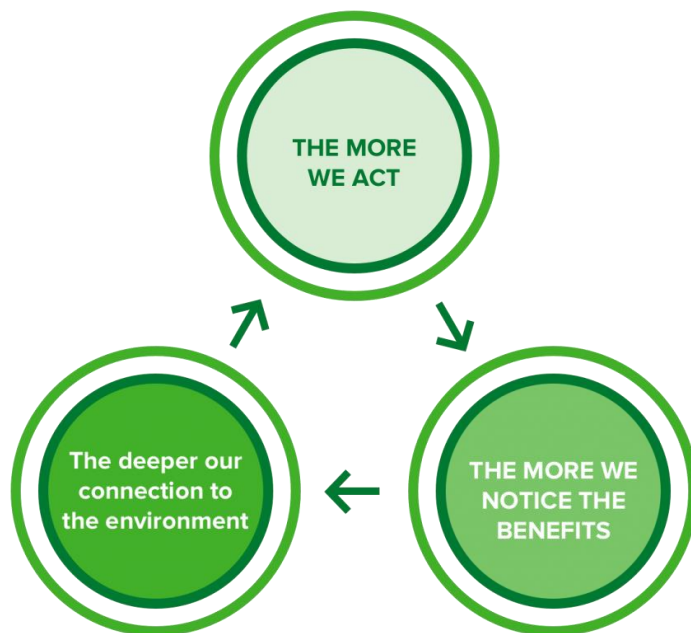
Primary Keynote Activity Ideas

Quick idea

Survey: Are any of these taking place at your school? What else is it doing?

Celebrate:

Climate Action Charter

Run a People's Assembly on ways to take climate action at school.

- It is like a debate but the aim is for people to agree a way forward instead of pitching one point of view against the other.
- In groups students create a short presentation on an idea or theme such as energy or food.
- Everyone can ask questions and input help refine the ideas.
- Recommendations could be passed to an eco-group or SLT.

Lesson ideas

Students can think about different forms of climate action based on words they are given to define it. I.e. Climate action is...

-growing vegetables
- ...asking difficult questions
- ...fun
-persuading
- ... happening too slowly
- ... doing nothing!
